

Last month's question...Can anyone remember the building that sat on the lot next to the Beauty Shop (where the old gas pumps were across from the store). What was the business that was in it? Who owned it?

This question got a lot of response – so much so, I am moving the answer inside the front cover so you all can enjoy what I found out. Wow... just wow. It's great to hear and see the stories from Olsburg past and I appreciate the response!

Here is your new question... Does anyone remember what was along Highway 16 (North side) where currently Brick's, gas pumps and old gas station is located? Were there houses? Businesses? I know the Highway wasn't always as it is now but have no idea what was there before.

What a fun month of discovering more about Olsburg's history! Many thanks to all of you who contributed with memories, pictures, and stories. The history of Olsburg is special – it's a piece of our past



and who we are and by remembering, the past can live on just a little bit (3)

The building in question across the street from The Farmhouse was once a machine shop and hardware store of sorts. When the stories first started coming in, I really thought everyone was saying "Elmer Borg" was the owner. Then a few more emails and conversations and the name "Yelmer Borg" came into play. I researched on-line, but was coming up empty

for any information on Yelmer Borg at all – that's where a spelling lesson comes in. Yes, his name was


Hjalmar Borg (pronounced Yelmer). Swedish roots should have told me to look into different spellings!

I was lucky enough to get in contract with Hjalmar's niece who lives in Manhattan. Her father, Leonard, was a brother to Hjalmar and she was wonderful to share some memories of her Uncle. Hjalmar was born in June of 1902 and made Olsburg his home. In speaking with locals who remember him, he was a very talented machinest who could fix anything. Farm implements, cars, tools – if it needed fixed you to it to "Borgs".

Donna remembers... Hjalmar used to take

food to a widow, Elsa Samuelson who ran the boarding house in Olsburg. She had lost her husband and had two young children, Delbert and Martha. She and Hjalmar fell in love and married and he gained a family. He was a talented mechanic and could fix anything!

Kirk Sours shared these memories: Borg lived across the street from us to the north west across from Reuben Larson. Unfortunately, he died in a house fire there from smoke inhalation. My dad (Benny) was



working nights and got home about 3 am in those days and noticed smoke. He entered the house to find Mr. Borg had succumbed already. Dad called the fire department and helped put the small fire out before it destroyed the home. Parker's lived there afterward and then Cassel's, and I think Shippy's after that. (It was most recently the home of the McCool's)

Mr. Borg did some auto repair out of that building on the back side. Dick Robbins bought it after Borg died, and the little building next to the ally served as a Granary for the Anchor D Ranch. Mark Parker and I sacked oats in there for a couple of winters after school \$1.50/hour. That's how I started ranching! LoL! The old building served as storage for the ranch; it was a solid old building, and the roof was tight, so it was dry, and we stored brome seed there after Rick Gibbs combined it for us. There was a large deck elevator that one person could power with the large rope and block pulley system. It was very cool. Some of us teens including Chuck, Pam and Brenda Johnson, myself, the Doughty boys and the Parker boys would hang out up in the top floor and practice throwing knives and hatchets. Had a lot of fun in there even though it had a spooky look to it on the outside. After I left Olsburg and came back to visit I




saw it had been razed and the gas pumps installed there. I thought downtown looked naked without it and the old high school (Fagerberg) building.

Martha Turner shared her memories of Borgs: The building that used to be west of Erin's store had at one time been a hardware store. It may have been other things as well. There are some old photos of the building that I have seen with some of the old-time glass topped gasoline pumps setting on the south side near the southwest entrance. The main entrance faced Erin's, on the east side of the building When Rick Gibbs tore it down, Dad went and explored the finds


inside. There had been a freight

elevator in the back, powered by a rope and pulley system. Wish dad was around to tell the story. I have some photos taken by Jane Gibbs of dad looking around the building.

Larry Anderson had many stories to tell about Hjalmar and his visits to his family farm our on Stoney Creek Rd North of town. Ace remembered the old car Hjalmar used to drive and the mishaps he went through! Kristi Fronce was gracious enough to share some old photos of the actual building, and Ace recognized the car in front as the one Hjalmar used to drive.



This was truly a journey for me. I learned more about this community I'm proud to call home and connected with folks who I haven't had the chance to for a while. I hope you enjoy the pictures (and if anyone can name the young gentlemen in the old photos that would be amazing!) We are now the keepers of the memories and to share is priceless. Thanks again – this was fun!





#### **City of Olsburg City Council** Meeting Summary, August 8, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Olsburg City Council was held August 8, 2023 at City Hall. A quorum was present.

#### **Guests present were:**

Keithen Meyer with Schwab-Eaton giving an update on funding applications for the sewer lagoon project and to get approval for taking the next steps in the funding process. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 19, 2023, 7:00 pm at City Hall as part of the funding process. Notice of the hearing will be published in the Manhattan Mercury.

Marcus Bryant with Olsburg Community PRIDE - Olsburg Land Utfärd submitted a request for use of City property during the poker run this year. The application was approved as an administrative action.

Tina Williams inquired about what would be involved with installing a privacy fence on her property and expressed concern regarding the condition of the sidewalk in front of her home.

Calvette Williams asked if the pothole on 1st Street and Birch could be filled in.

#### **Business Brought Before the Council:**

Minutes from the July 11, 2023 meeting were approved. The Treasurer's Report was presented and as well as bills to be paid. Both were approved.

Regarding potholes: A second load of cold mix will be ordered to make repairs on streets.

There was discussion to make repairs to American flags on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to prevent winding around the poles. Placing American flags along Highway 16 was also discussed.

Ordinance NO. 382 Regulating the Building and Construction of Fences within the City Limits of the City of Olsburg was presented, discussed and approved.

An updated Fireworks ordinance was discussed. A draft of the ordinance was discussed and will be sent to the City Attorney for review.

The next meeting of the Olsburg City Council will be the Revenue Neutral Rate and the 2024 Budget Public Hearings on Tuesday, August 22, 2023, 7:00 pm at City Hall.


#### Here are the guidelines!


