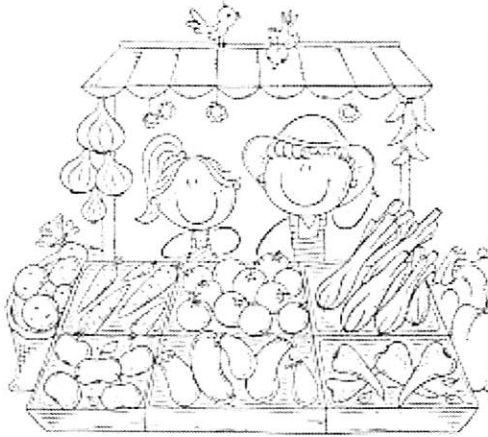


Olsburg Community PRIDE

3. Dorothy and Opal spent a lot of their time together. You could often see them driving around town or the community together. What a special gift to have your sister as your best friend!

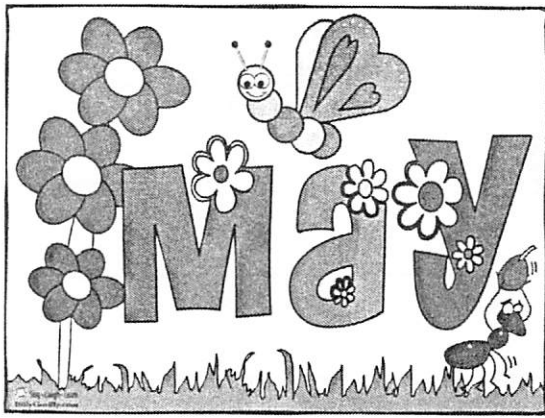
We fondly remember both of them. They were "gifts" to our community and they are missed.

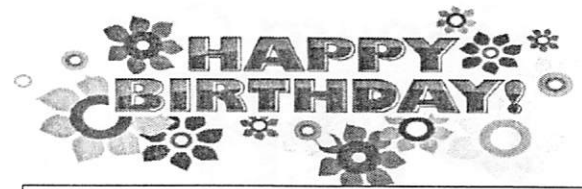
1. This young man has a nickname that he shares with the dad on the Simpsons.

A quorum was not present to conduct business.

Present were Mayor Aric Cassel, Council Members Mike Mayer and Cindy Pfaff. Also, present were City Treasurer Gregg Gibson and City Clerk Jeannie Johnson. Council Members David Gibson, Karl Kasselmann and Kyle Rootring were absent.

Guests: Pottawatomie County Commissioner Terry Force, Jim Didas and Pottawatomie County Deputy Dale Rice.

Minutes March 5, 2025 Regular Meeting minutes could not be approved.

Public Comment: No public comments.

Treasurer Report: The March 2025 Treasurer's Report could not be approved.

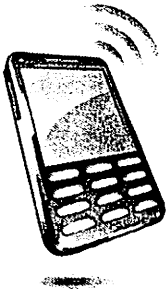

The text message service is the fastest way for the City to get information out to our residents, which can be critical in the event of a major weather event and residents need to know how to respond.

We are making it easier for *residents* of the City of Olsburg to opt in to receive text messages from the City.

- ❖ Your email will serve as your agreement to opt in to the text message service.

UTILITY BILL

In the next few months, the City will begin using a new billing format. It will take a little time for us to get the change fully made from our present utility billing software to the new, updated format. At this time, we are a few weeks away from getting started with this change. Your patience is appreciated during the transition.

Local Elections Will Be Held November 4, 2025

Anyone interested in running for Mayor or City Council contact City Hall, 785-468-3209, or the Pottawatomie County Election Office 785-457-3314. The **filing deadline is June 2nd at NOON**. If you are interested, you **must file IN PERSON** at the County Clerk's office at 207 N 1st Westmoreland, KS.



If a candidate does not choose to file for election, their name will not appear on the ballot in November and they will need to run a write-in campaign.

The position of Mayor and two Council seats are up for election.

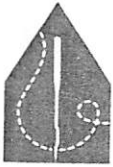
Qualifications to be a Candidate (whether filed or not) are:
