Call to Order - There being a quorum present the regular meeting of the Olsburg City Council was called to order by Mayor Aric Cassel at 7:03 PM.

Present were Mayor Aric Cassel, Council Members John White, Marcelino Abuerne, Kyle Rootring, City Treasurer Gregg Gibson and City Clerk Jeannie Johnson. Absent were Council Members David Gibson and Karl Kasselmann.

Approve Minutes: February 4, 2026 and March 4, 2026 minutes were approved.

Guests: Deputy Schiavo from the Pottawatomie County Sheriff's Office

Public Comment: No public comments were presented.

Treasurer Report: February 2026 and March 2026 Treasurer Reports were approved.

City Water Operator Report –Blockcolsky was not present to give a report.

City Maintenance Manager Report – Klenda was not present to give a report.

Clerk Report – Presented in written form.

The Meeting was adjourned at 9:06 pm.

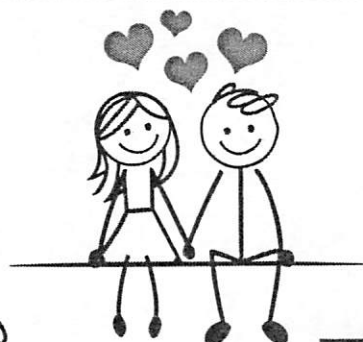

Text Message Service: The Quickest, Easiest Way to Get Information

As we approach summer, please consider opting in to our city text message service. Opting in will allow you to receive alerts from the city regarding information you need for changes in trash service, following storms and other urgent notifications. The text message service is the fastest way for the City to get information out to our residents, which can be critical in the event of a major weather event and residents need to know how to respond.



We are making it easier for *residents* of the City of Olsburg to opt in to receive text messages from the City.

- ❖ All you need to do is send the following information via email to olsburgcity@twinvalley.net:
- ❖ Please provide the following information:
 - 1) The phone number to be added.
 - 2) The name of the person whose phone is to be added.
 - 3) The address of the person whose phone is to be added.
- ❖ Your email will serve as your agreement to opt in to the text message service.

Last year several Non-Acceptable items were discarded in the roll off. Please review the lists above and comply with the items that are acceptable.

Items considered non-acceptable will be removed from the roll off by the company providing the service. This creates additional costs to the City in locating where those items can be disposed of, hauling items away, additional disposal fees and extra time for City staff and Council Members.

If non-acceptable items continue to be disposed of, the City may have no choice but to stop offering this service to the community.

Also be aware there are video cameras at City Park. Video will be reviewed daily for violations which may result in your items being returned to you or charging you for additional costs incurred by the City for non-compliance.

PLEASE NOTE: This service is provided for residents living inside the Olsburg City Limits ONLY.

Increase in Sewer Rates Addressed

As most everyone is aware, the City wastewater lagoons recently underwent some improvements which included dredging each cell installation of new weir gate structures to maximize flow of waste between each of the three cells, and construction of a wetland cell for emergency discharge.

Our wastewater system was built in 1977 and was no longer processing waste as required by Kansas Department of Health and Environment and was in dire need of an upgrade before the system was red flagged by KDHE and therefore in violation of the system permit.

The total cost of the project was \$699,502.00. A grant of \$490,000.00 was awarded leaving a loan amount of \$209,502.00 from the State Revolving Fund. The City will make two payments of \$4,531.41 twice a year for the next 20 years.

- Beginning April 1, 2026, sewer rates increase \$6.00 per month to maintain adequate funds for loan repayment and a fund balance for sewer maintenance.
- Residential rates: from \$18.00/month to \$24.00/month;
- School from \$31.00/month to \$37.00/month;
- Restaurants from \$22.00/month to \$28.00/month;
- Business and Commercial from \$31.00/month to \$37.00/month.

Rate increases will be seen on utility bills sent in May 2026 for April's service. There is no change in rates for trash service.

Spring Yard Clean Up

With spring comes that eagerness to get your yard cleaned up and looking fresh.

As you are tidying up please be aware that limbs and debris from winter weather are **your** responsibility to remove from your property. This is the policy for routine property maintenance.

The brush dump is for limbs and grass only. No other items are permitted. The dump is inspected from time to time by the State and if items other than those listed above are found, the City could lose our permit, so please be mindful of what you are taking to the dump.

A key for the City brush dump is available at City Hall or most Council Members have a key they can loan you.

April Spotlight: Clear the Clutter Safely

The Issue: During big clean-out projects, hazardous items like motor oil, pool chemicals, and oil-based paints often end up in the trash by mistake. These items pose a serious fire risk to Waste Management trucks and can lead to environmental hazards if they leak.

Safe Disposal Tips:

- **Separate the Hazards:** If a product is flammable or toxic, it should not go in your household trash. Please contact the Pottawatomie County Transfer Station 8585 Wheaton Road, Wamego, KS 66547, Phone: 785-456-9706 for information on where a local hazardous waste drop-off point is located.
- **Bag for Safety:** Ensure all loose spring-cleaning debris — like old rags, dust, or small household items — is securely bagged to prevent litter during collection.
- **Repurpose First:** If you are clearing out furniture, clothes, or working appliances, consider a local donation center. Giving items a second life is a great way to ensure Material is Repurposed.

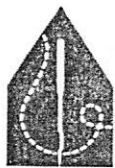
