Anyone interested in running for Mayor or City Council contact City Hall, 785-468-3209, or the Pottawatomie County Election Office 785-457-3314.

PLEASE NOTE:

Write-in candidate's names will not appear on the ballot. As the name implies, those people will need to conduct a campaign to have constituents write their name on the ballot when voting.

Having the correct spelling of the write-in candidate is vital. You may take information with you for the purpose of voting, however, you must make sure you take that information with you when you exit the voting booth.

Current Mayor, Aric Cassel has filed for re-election with the Pottawatomie County Elections Office. His name will appear on the November ballot.

Qualifications to be a Candidate are:

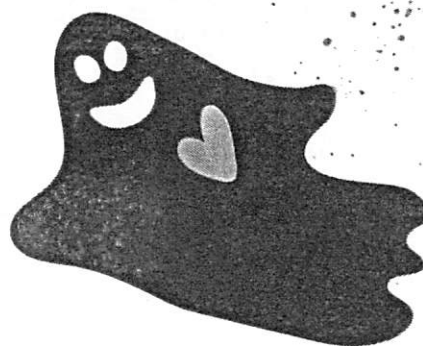
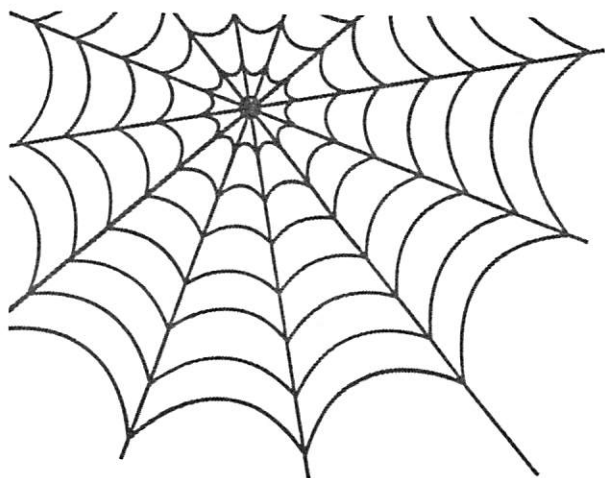
- ✓ Must be 21 years of age
