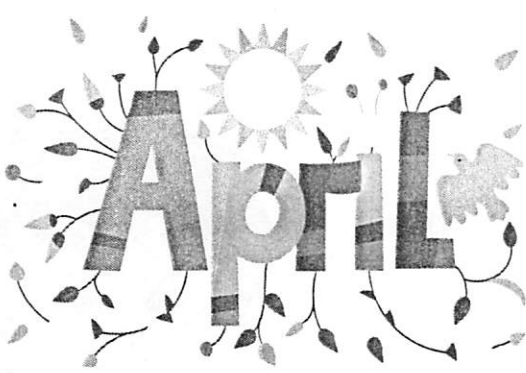
Alert Road Race 2024

City of Olsburg
Regular Meeting Summary
March 5, 2025, 7:00 PM

Call to Order

Seeing there was a quorum present to conduct business; the regular meeting of the Olsburg City Council was called to order by Mayor Aric Cassel at 7:00 pm.

Present were Mayor Aric Cassel, Council Members Mike Mayer, Karl Kasselmann, Cindy Pfaff and Kyle Rootring. Also, present was City Treasurer Gregg Gibson and City Clerk Jeannie Johnson. Council Member David Gibson was absent.

Guests: Brody Buchanan was present to observe the meeting.

Minutes of the February 5, 2025 meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report The February 2025 Treasurer's Report was approved and bills to be paid were presented.

Council member Reports:

- a. Street – Mike Mayer – Debris from demolition of the red brick building has been transferred to the rolloff dumpster. There is still part of the foundation that needs to be removed. A jackhammer attachment for the skid loader will be rented to break up the remaining debris that needs to be removed.
- b. Water- Kyle Rootring – No Report
- c. Sewer – Karl Kasselmann – No Report
- d. Parks - David Gibson – Absent
- e. President- Cindy Pfaff – No Report

Old Business:

- a. The City of Olsburg Emergency Operations/Disaster Response Plan was approved
- b. The Resident Emergency Response Guideline was approved and a copy of the Guideline will be mailed to each household and business in the City.

New Business:

- a. After Prom Donation to the Blue Valley After Prom of \$150.00 was approved.
- b. Snow Removal from Winter Storm Blair – Pottawatomie County did not meet the \$116,000.00 threshold to qualify for State assistance under Governor Kelly's Disaster Declaration.
- c. The Mayor is meeting with an electrician on March 6, 2025 to get an estimate to get the wells set up for a generator and the cost of a generator. Estimates for generators will be made through several suppliers.

Kasselmann moved to pay bills. Pfaff seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Rooting moved to adjourn the meeting. Mayer seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:07 pm.

Emergency Preparedness Guideline

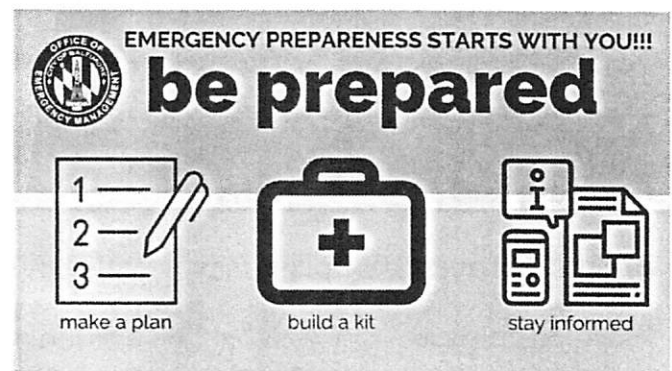
The Olsburg City Council approved an Emergency Response Guideline at the March meeting.

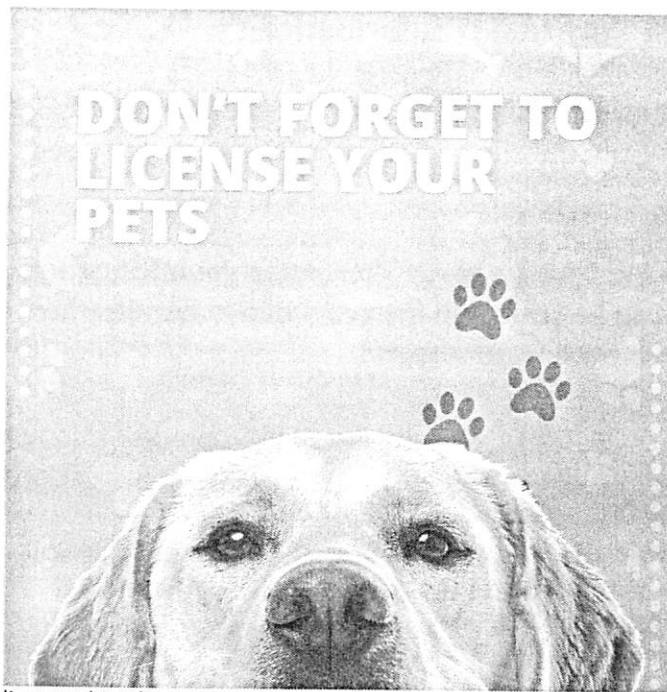
A copy of the Guideline will be mailed to each household/business within the City of Olsburg so please be watching for it.

The purpose of the Guideline is to provide information to residents regarding steps that are recommended to be taken to prepare for most emergencies and is based on the City's Emergency Operations/Disaster Response Plan which was also approved in March.

Extended Deadline to Get Dogs Licensed to April 15th.

Dog Licenses and Rabies Vaccinations – The City of Olsburg requires all dogs to be licensed by order of Ordinance NO 348 (available online cityofolsburg.com/ordinances).

✓ To receive your pet tags, please complete a License Application, provide a copy of your pet's vaccinations. A recent photo of your pet(s) on file is also helpful.

✓ Tags are \$5.00/each for spayed and neutered dogs, \$15.00/each for un-spayed and un-neutered dogs.

✓ Licensing your pet and having a photo helps us find you if your pet becomes lost; rabies vaccinations prevent the spread of the deadly rabies virus and protects the public.

✓ If you own a dog that has not been

licensed in the past now is the time to get your fur baby registered. We get many calls asking who the owner of a dog might be, but we can't answer that question because the pet is not licensed, and we don't have a photo of the dog.

ALL dogs living within the city limits are required to be tagged.

Building and Fence Permits –

As spring arrives, your plans may include building a fence or adding a utility shed on your property.

When planning an improvement to the exterior of a building, such as a deck, patio, utility shed, etc., please make getting a building permit at the top of your list. Building permits for construction are required within the city limits for any structure over 50 square feet. Cost of a permit is \$0.05per square foot, \$20.00 minimum. All permits must be approved prior to construction starting. ***Please allow at least 2-3 weeks*** for permits to be approved.

Fence construction also requires a fence permit which is a flat \$5.00. As with building permits, ***please allow at least 2-3 weeks*** for a permit to be approved before beginning construction.

Both building and fence permits can be downloaded and printed from the cityofolsburg.com website. Look for the News & Information tab then click on Documents and Forms.

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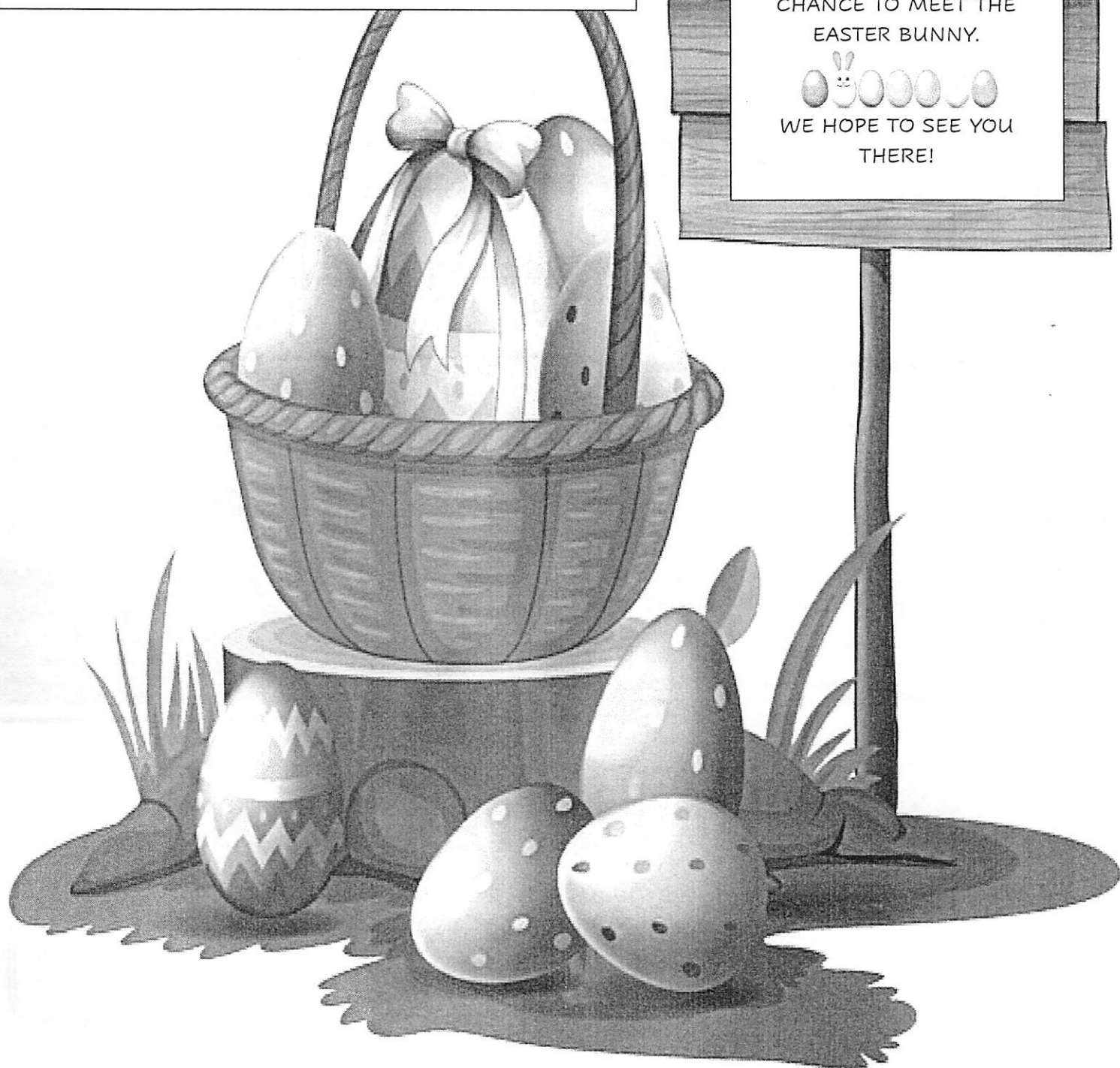

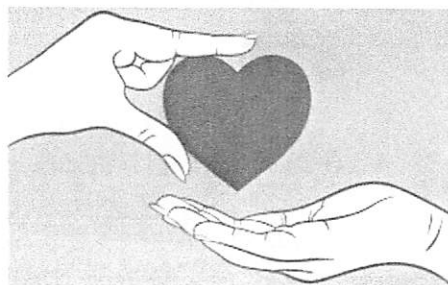


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Walk Kansas to Celebrate 25 Years

In the midst of thousands of Kansans rallying around a challenge to walk or roll a distance equivalent to the length of the state, Sharolyn Jackson believes one goal should always be kept in mind.

“It’s important to have fun,” said Jackson, a family and consumer sciences specialist in K-State Research and Extension’s northeast region. Jackson is also coordinator of the popular Walk Kansas program, which turns 25 this year. ‘Fun,’ she says, has been a cornerstone of the health and fitness program since its beginning more than a quarter-century ago.

“The best physical activity is one you will actually do. There are so many spillover effects from physical activity that include being more productive at work, being more satisfied in your life, improving your mood and improving your outlook on life,” Jackson said.

Walk Kansas is a team-based challenge that encourages people to walk, jog, run, roll, bike, swim or do whatever they enjoy doing to live more healthfully. The program routinely draws more than 5,000 participants.

Online registration for the 2025 Walk Kansas program opens on March 4. Each team must assign a captain, in addition to a team name. The cost per team member is \$10, which must be paid at the time the captain registers the team.

Each team of friends, family members or others is made of six members who set a goal to engage in moderate exercise for a minimum 150 minutes per week, for eight weeks. Each team members’ exercise minutes translate to miles and the team’s total over eight weeks is roughly equivalent to 423 miles, or the distance across Kansas – east to west. If team members decide they want to do more, they can sign up for various challenges outlined on the Walk Kansas website.

If you don’t have a team, or just prefer to take on the challenge yourself, there is a solo participant option. You do not need to live in Kansas to be on a team or to do the solo challenge.

“The minimum guideline for health is 150 minutes per week at moderate intensity (set by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention), or you can go at a more vigorous pace and get the same benefit with less time,” Jackson said. “It’s up to each team and team member as to how they want to structure their exercise, and we’ll explore a lot of the benefits, how-to’s and more in our weekly newsletter and webinars.”

Walk Kansas began on a local level more than 25 years ago, then grew to a statewide program in 2001, according to Jackson. It remains an eight-week program, which she notes, “is long enough to help people get into a routine.”

Build a relationship with Sponsors and collecting items.

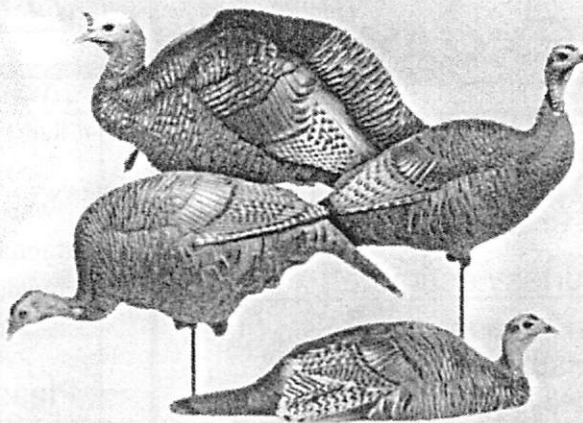
