Kansas Horse Council Executive Director Honored with National Van Ness Award

Congratulations, Justine Staten, Executive Director of the Kansas Horse Council! The commitment and energy Justine expends representing all facets of the equine industry in Kansas are unmatched!!

The Van Ness Award is presented to an individual who best emulates the dedication and commitment of Marjorie Van Ness to the advancement and improvement of the horse industry at the state level. This year, the honor was awarded to Justine Staten, Executive Director of the Kansas Horse Council and Chair of the Coalition of State Horse Councils.

Since stepping into the role of Executive Director in 2017, Justine Staten has been a steady and passionate leader within the Kansas equine industry—though her connection to the organization stretches back much further. She first began volunteering with the Kansas Horse Council in 2002, building a long history of service and commitment to the state's horse community.

Her dedication to the equine industry extends far beyond Kansas. Justine currently serves as a Board Trustee for the American Horse Council (2022–2026) and has been active in multiple leadership roles, including her ongoing service on the Kansas Department of Agriculture's Marketing Advisory Board since 2017.

In addition to her statewide and national leadership, she has contributed locally through long-term involvement with the Black Jack Saddle Club, serving in various board officer roles since 2012, and currently serves on the board of Carnahan Creek Church and Carnahan-Garrison Creek Cemetery (2024–present), supporting the maintenance of public-use trail systems within Carnahan Creek Recreational Park. Staten's career reflects a deep, consistent commitment to strengthening the equine industry through leadership, service, and collaboration at every level.

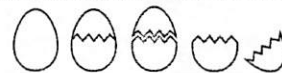

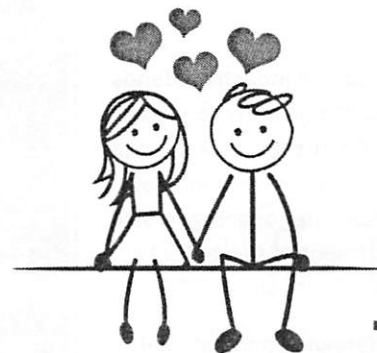

Guests: Terry Force, District 5 Pottawatomie County Commissioner updated the Council regarding the County building located at 320 2nd Street. Force also stated there will be a County Planning and Zoning meeting August 20, 2026 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Wamego, 6:30 pm regarding data center issues in the county.

The Meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm.

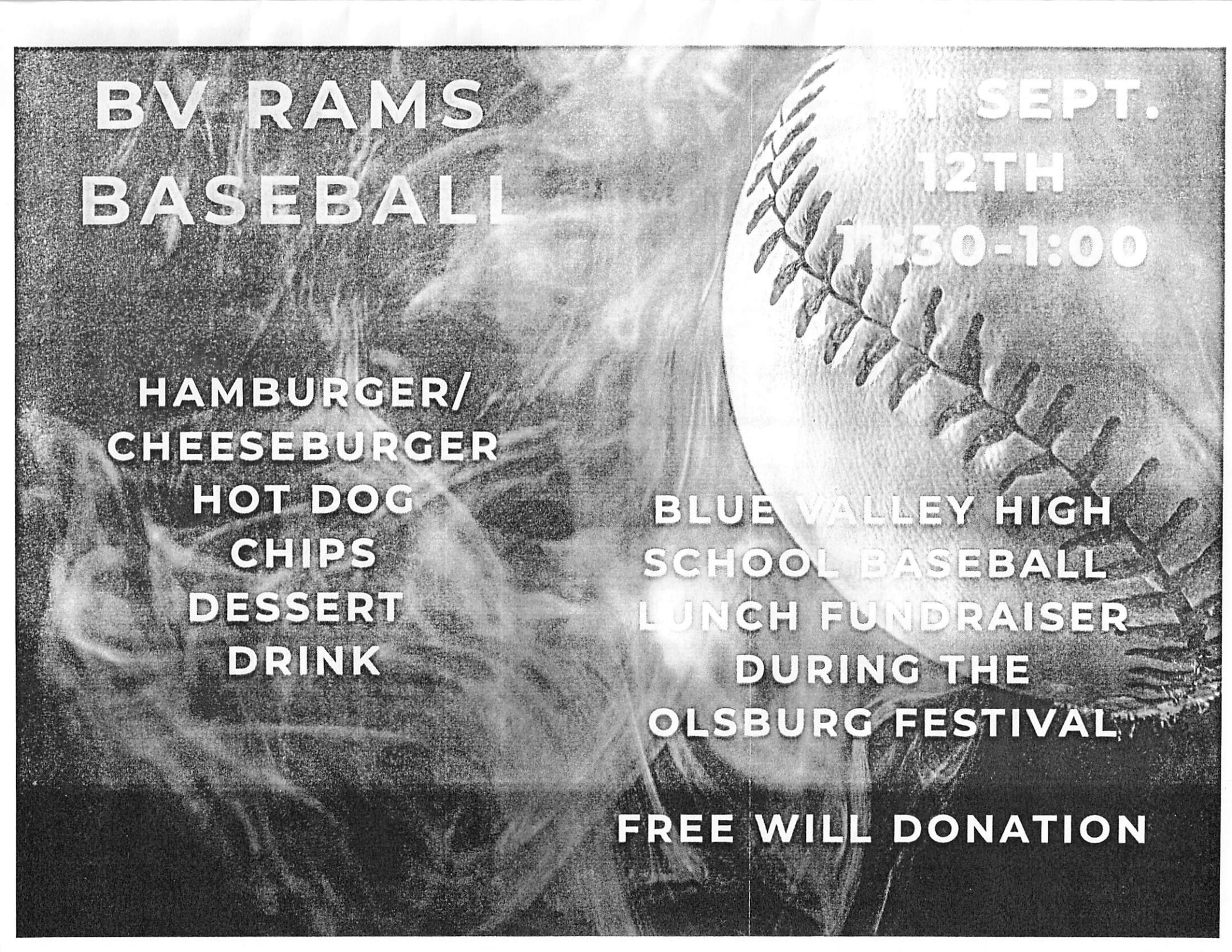
