There have been several comments recently regarding ATV drivers around town.

The primary complaint is the young drivers are going a bit fast and loud.

When people are out walking their dogs, the dogs are startled and bolt away from their owners.

Please follow the rules of the road for ATVs (K.S.A. Article 15 8-15, 100). The laws are the same within the boundaries of the city as they are outside the city limits. The 2019 statute says in part:

- The operator of the all-terrain vehicle/work-site utility vehicle ***must be a licensed driver*** and be operating within the restrictions of the operator's license;

Well, there is no clever saying that expresses the kindness of a dog owner toward their fellow humans by picking up poop after their dog, but maybe there should be.

There have been a number of complaints recently pertaining to dog owners not picking up poop after their dogs.

# **PREAMBLE TO THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE**



“We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.—That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed,—That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.”

**Regular Meeting Summary, June 5, 2024, 7:00 PM**

**Call to Order**

Seeing there was a quorum present to conduct business, the regular meeting of the Olsburg City Council was called to order by President of the Council, Cindy Pfaff at 7:02 pm.

Present were President Cindy Pfaff, Council Members Mike Mayer, Kyle Rootring, Karl Kasselmann and David Gibson. Also, present were City Treasurer Gregg Gibson and City Clerk Jeannie Johnson. Absent was Mayor Aric Cassel.

**Guests:** No guests were present

**Approve Minutes:** Minutes of the April 3, 2024, Regular Meeting minutes were approved. A summary of the May meeting was reviewed.

**Public Comment:** No public comment

**Treasurer Report:** The April 3, 2024, and May 8, 2024 Treasurer's Reports were approved and bills were presented.

**Clerk Report**

**Council member Reports:**

- a. Street – Mike Mayer – Cold mix will need to be ordered to fill some of the potholes around town.
- b. Water- Kyle Rootring – No Report
- c. Sewer – Karl Kasselmann – No Report
- d. Parks - David Gibson – No Report
- e. President- Cindy Pfaff – Suggested making sure there is a reminder in the community newsletter and on Facebook regarding the firing of fireworks and the time frame which displays are permitted.

**Old Business:**

- a. Office Upgrade – The upgrade is mostly complete. There are a few minor things to finish up. Overall, the remodel is well received.

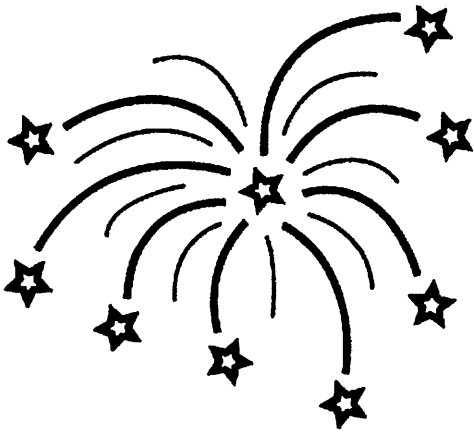
**New Business:**

- a. There has not been any type of protection for historical records up to this time. A Liberty Safe Model USA 36, Fire rated at 60 minutes, for \$2,000.00 was approved for purchase.
- b. Insurance Coverage – The City has received a letter from Nationwide Insurance, stating they will cease insurance coverage for municipalities in the State of Kansas. A broker will be engaged to seek new coverage that will take effect by August 1, 2024.
- c. Hydrant Meter Quotes –A hydrant meter which is becoming more necessary to monitor the usage of water when filling water tankers and similar bulk water equipment. A quote from Salina Supply Company was approved for \$2,371.80.
- d. Steve Lundberg will be removing and salvaging what he can from the city-owned red brick building on E. Elm Street at a cost of \$2,000.00. Work will begin in August 2024.
- e. One truck load of cold mix for pothole repairs was approved for purchase.
- f. Line Locator – Information is being gathered regarding a line locator for identifying water lines. The equipment will make it easier for water lines to be located and avoid damage to the water system.
- g. ID Badges – In light of the disaster in Westmoreland on April 30<sup>th</sup> the City has requested the Pottawatomie County Emergency Management Office provide ID Badges for Olsburg City Councilmembers and Employees. In the event there is a major disaster here, the ID badges will provide city officials and employees with immediate access into the city.

Gibson moved to pay bills. Mayer seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Gibson moved to adjourn the meeting. Rootring seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:50 pm.



## Make Plans Now for July 4<sup>th</sup> Celebrations

This is a reminder that the City of Olsburg passed an ordinance (No. 383) addressing the discharge of fireworks within the City Limits of Olsburg.

Fireworks may be discharged

- \* Between the hours of 8:00 am and 11:00 P.M. on June 29<sup>th</sup> through July 3<sup>rd</sup>
- \* Between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 12:00 midnight on July 4<sup>th</sup> and
- \* Between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M. on July 5<sup>th</sup>

The Section 3 of the ordinance further states:

(d) The governing body of the City of Olsburg may, in its discretion, grant permission at any time for the public display of fireworks by responsible individuals or organizations when such display or displays shall be of such character and so located, discharged and fired, as not to be a fire hazard or endanger persons or surrounding property.

(e) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, to give any public display of fireworks without having first obtained a permit therefore.

Section 6 also states:

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to fire or provide a fireworks display for the public or for organized groups without first obtaining a permit to do so by making application at least thirty (30) days in advance of the desired display. Approval of the permit shall be by the governing body.

A copy of Ordinance No. 383 is on record with the Pottawatomie County Sheriff's Office Dispatch.

As always, please be aware of pets and humans who are sensitive to loud noises. If possible, contact neighbors to make them aware of any plans to shoot off fireworks during the designated times allowed.
